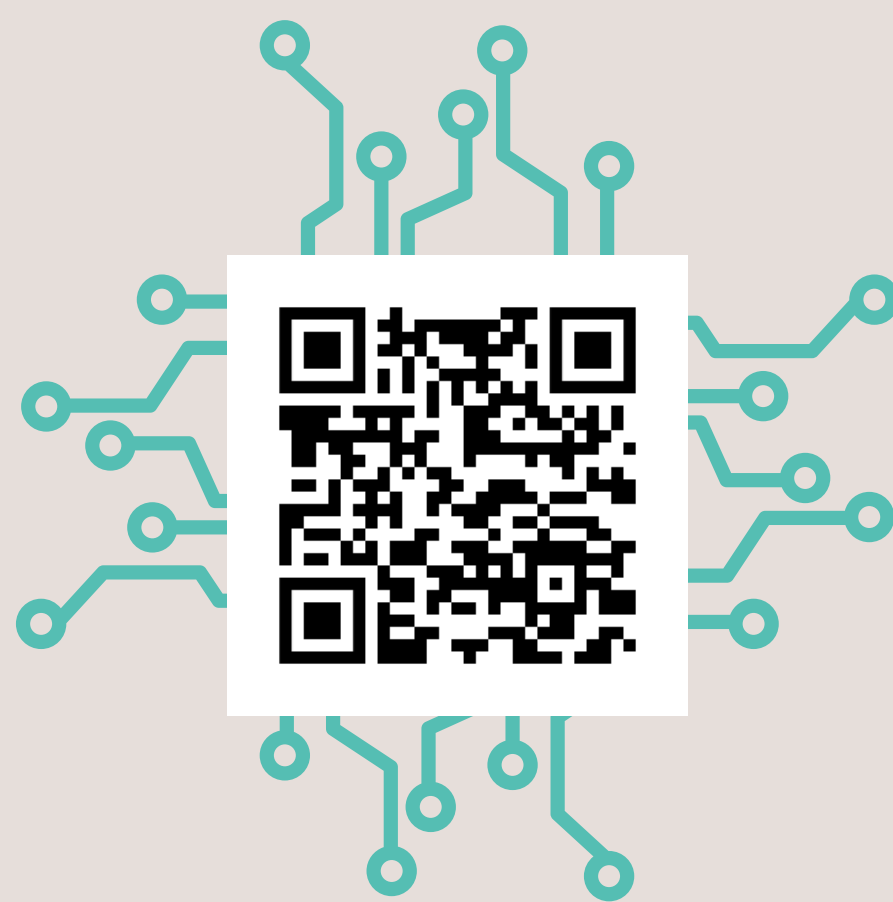

Recognizing the imperative to confront and mitigate these challenges strategically, the Directorate of Forensic Sciences, Home (Police) Department, Government of Meghalaya in collaboration with the National Law University Meghalaya (NLU Meg) and experts from the National Forensic Science University and the field of forensics are collectively convening this **Symposium on Digital Forensics and Cyber Crime** under the theme of ***Strengthening Cyber Forensics: Navigating the Digital Frontier***. The symposium will centrally focus on the realms of cyber forensics and law, aspire to cultivate an environment conducive to interdisciplinary collaboration among diverse agencies. The overarching objective is to fortify collective efforts in combating cybercrime through the judicious application of technological advancements.

The primary objectives of the symposium are:

1. Augmenting comprehension: To enrich the understanding of cyber forensics and digital forensics among law enforcement agencies, legal professionals, and experts in the realms of digital and forensic sciences.

2. Examining Proactive and Reactive Cyber Forensics: To scrutinize the conceptual foundations of Proactive and Reactive Cyber Forensics and elucidate their substantive roles in preempting and investigating instances of cybercrime.

3. Showcasing State-of-the-Art Cyber Forensics Monitoring: To present and deliberate upon the cutting-edge developments inherent in the State of the Art Cyber Forensics Monitoring system, with a specific focus on its potential efficacy in surveilling and mitigating cyber threats.

4. Boundary delineation between Police Cyber Forensics and Laboratory Cyber Forensics: To engender a discourse on demarcating the delineation between Police Cyber Forensics and Laboratory Cyber Forensics, fostering a coordinated and efficacious approach to cybercrime investigation.

5. Cultivating Collaboration and Knowledge Sharing: To facilitate a collaborative platform for agencies involved, thereby promoting knowledge exchange and concerted efforts in the collective endeavour to combat cybercrime.

The Symposium will encompass a series of interactive sessions, presentations, and panel discussions centred around the following topics:
